Halal Traceability

Ensuring that products meet the requirements of Islamic law from source to consumer -> including slaughter practices, ingredient sourcing and halal financing.

Increasing Global Demand for Halal Products and its role in the Global Economy

According to the State of the Global Islamic Economy Report by DinarStandard, the global halal economy was valued at approximately \$2.29 trillion in 2022, with significant contributions from sectors like halal food, Islamic finance, and lifestyle products. This market is expected to grow to around \$2.5 trillion by 2025 as these sectors continue to expand.



Current Issues in Ensuring Halal Compliance

Lack of Transparency

Traditional methods often lack transparency, often making it difficult to trace products back to their origin and verify compliance.

Complexity & Fraud

The complexity of global supply chains creates vulnerabilities of fraud and mislabeling, undermining consumer trust and market integrity.

Limited Traceability

Majority of the halal products lack comprehensive traceability systems making it difficult to track their journey from farm to table.

If any part of the Halal product is haram (e.g., the financing used to create the product is Haram) it will impact the whole Halal value chain.







1.1 The dashboard provides a central viewpoint identifying the company's inventory and tracked items




1.2 Inventory list shows a list of items that are being tracked

1.3 The item data shows the data that is stored within for the item as well ad add provide options to add data.






1.4 The Unisot Product passport shows the product and the relevant data for better transparency

1.5 Track and Trace system allows the user to track the item geographically and the certificate section shows the the stored Halal certification








